Accommodation details**

AGH University of Science and Technology (AGH UST), and particularly UNESCO AGH Chair, in consultation with the AGH UST Student Campus Authorities (MS AGH), offers for UNESCO AGH Chair Fellows edition 2017 in Engineering the accommodation during the academic year 2017/2018. We offer accommodation in the AGH UST dormitories based on both comfort and basic standards.

We kindly ask all the UNESCO AGH Fellows edition 2017, interested in accommodation in our dormitories at the AGH UST campus, to choose the standard type of accommodation (stating your surname and name and home country). Please do the automatic registration which is available at www.unesco.agh.edu.pl, folder AGH UNESCO Chair » UNESCO/AGH Fellowships » Selected Fellows Application Form, click correct edition (IT IS OBLIGATORY, no later than September 1, 2017.). The late confirmation will result in NO accommodation guarantee at the AGH UST Campus. The accommodation at the Campus is the best option for you.

All rooms have free access to the Internet and cable television access. In the dormitories are also available study rooms, TV rooms and club rooms equipped with a variety of team games. The AGH UST Campus infrastructure includes also: student clubs, billiard club, sports fields, tennis courts, fitness clubs, kindergarten, post office, supermarket and a variety of retail outlets, catering and service.

1. Comfort Plus

Those double rooms, each with a bathroom, are dedicated to postgraduate UNESCO AGH Chair fellows.

The kitchenette is equipped with a refrigerator with freezer, kitchen worktop, wall cabinets, utility cupboard and clothes hangers. In the bathroom you will find shower, sink, toilet, towel racks, trash can and towel rack heater type.

In rooms are available: telephone, desk with chairs, wardrobe, standard size bed with mattress, blanket, quilt, pillow and bed linen, as well as shelves for books and personal belongings.

In the dorm you can also use a kitchen located on each floor, equipped with oven, double chamber sink and hotplates to prepare your own meals. The kitchens are generally available to all residents of the dorm 24 hours per day. Kitchens are not equipped with dishes and cutlery. Residents can also use a laundry room. The keys to the laundry room are available at the dormitory registration front desk, but first you have to make a reservation. Laundries are equipped with automatic washing machines and electric dryers. Laundry is not equipped with washing powders, washing liquids, and other chemical products. In addition, at the reception you can borrow free without any additional charge an iron and vacuum cleaner (but you have to show your dormitory ID card). Each resident has free access to the Internet based on symmetric bandwidth speed of 100 Mbit / s.

Each resident has free access to the internal AGH UST phone system. Also, all residents have free access to book a laundry, sports fields (football, volleyball, basketball) and tennis courts located in the AGH UST campus.

Monthly accommodation fee based on a comfort plus is 410 PLN. The fees for accommodation in the AGH UST Student Campus is defined in the price list, which is updated either by 1st October or by 1st March each year. Upgrade pricing resulting in a change amount of the fees intended for all residents of AGH UST campus, including the UNESCO AGH UST Fellows. The fee covers all costs of stay (including: electricity, heating, hot and cold water, garbage collection, sewage, protection of the MS AGH area), access to the Internet 24/7 without restrictions and change of linen once a month at least. All residents in their own store in towels, toilet paper, personal hygiene, chemical products and kitchenware.

2. Standard Comfort (the number of places is limited - first come first served)

The accommodation in Standard Comfort is based on furnished double type rooms connected in a two-room studio. Each studio has:

- kitchenette with a refrigerator with freezer, kitchen worktop - wall cabinets and single chamber sink with drainer function, utility cupboard and clothes hangers,
- bathroom with a shower, sink, toilet, towel racks, trash can, towel rack heater type.

In rooms are available: telephone, desk with chairs, wardrobe, standard size bed with mattress, blanket, quilt, pillow and bed linen, as well as shelves for books and personal belongings.

In the dorm you can also use located on each floor kitchen, equipped with oven, double chamber sink and hotplates to prepare your own meals. The kitchens are generally available to all residents of the dorm 24 hours per day. Kitchens are not equipped with dishes and cutlery. Residents can also use a laundry room. The keys to the laundry room are available at the dormitory registration front desk, but first you

Upgrade pricing resulting in a change amount of the fees intended for all residents of AGH UST campus, including the UNESCO AGH UST Fellows. The fee covers all costs of stay (including: electricity, heating, hot and cold water, garbage collection, sewage, protection of the MS AGH area), access to the Internet 24/7 without restrictions, and change of linen once a month at least. All residents in their own store in towels, toilet paper, personal hygiene, chemical products and kitchenware.

3. Standard Basic (the number of places is limited - first come first served)

The accommodation in Standard Basic are based on furnished rooms, where there is a telephone, refrigerator, desk, chairs, wardrobe, bed with mattress, blanket, duvet, pillow and bed linen and shelves for books and personal belongings. For four rooms (complex which include two doubles and two triple rooms) is one common sanitary facility with a shower. In the dorm you can also use located on each floor kitchen, equipped with oven, double chamber sink and hotplates to prepare your own meals. The kitchens are generally available to all residents of the dorm 24 hours per day. Kitchens are not equipped with dishes and cutlery.

Residents can also use a laundry room. The keys to the laundry room are available at the dormitory registration front desk, but first you have to make a reservation. Laundries are equipped with automatic washing machines and electric dryers. Laundry is not equipped with washing powders, washing liquids, and other chemical products. In addition, at the reception you can borrow free without any additional charge an iron and vacuum cleaner (but you have to show your dormitory ID card). Each resident has free access to the Internet based on symmetric bandwidth speed of 100 Mbit / s.

Accommodation details

Monthly fee for accommodation based on a standard basic is 350 PLN. The fees for accommodation at the AGH UST Student Campus is defined in the price list, which is updated either by 1st October or by 1st March each year. Upgrade pricing resulting in a change amount of the fees intended for all residents of campus, including the UNESCO AGH Fellows. The fee covers all costs of stay (including: electricity, heating, hot and cold water, garbage collection, sewage, protection of the MS AGH area), access to the Internet 24/7 without restrictions and change of linen once a month at least. All residents in their own store in towels, toilet paper, personal hygiene, chemical products and kitchenware.

4. Obligations of UNESCO AGH Fellows

Each residents of AGH UST Campus have to sign the declaration of acceptance and observance of the rules of use of the allocated accommodation (*Annex 01 accommodation rules*). A monthly fee for accommodation at the AGH UST Campus is valid from October 01, 2017 and is charged irrespective of the date of accommodation (arrival date). Period of Fellow stay at AGH UST Campus must be consistent with the present contract and agreed with the UNESCO AGH Chair directly.

The fee for accommodation at the AGH UST Campus will be automatically deducted from the fellowship funds on a monthly basis. The cost of all damages incurred during the stay, fellows will bear personally and must pay from their own financial resources.

About the date of arrival and departure please each time inform by email (unesco3@agh.edu.pl) the AGH UNESCO Chair in advance 14 days. Each inhabitant should personally check out on the day of departure at the reception desk of dormitory.

5. AGH UST Student Campus

The AGH UST Student Campus is the largest student campus in Poland located within the boundaries of the greater university campus between the streets of Reymonta, Tokarskiego, Nawojki, and Miechowska. The location of campus (20 minute walk to the city main point the Market Square) and good transport connections allow its residents to easily and quickly reach all corners of the City of Krakow. The campus consists of 20 student houses and offers over 7000 beds to the students of the AGH UST and other Krakow universities. The immediate vicinity of the AGH UST allows residents actively participate in the life of the University.

The AGH UST Campus include one of the largest concert clubs in Poland, so called the Studio Club. Every year his repertoire include dozens of events, in which Polish and foreign artists are involved. The clubs offer includes: concerts, cabarets, parties in the framework of Juvenilia of Krakow, student Beanalia and weekly largest student discos in Krakow. The club Zascianek periodically hosts concerts by young artists encountered in the DachOOFka Festival, student discos, karaoke with a live band and so-called Spiewo-granie. The Gwarek Club organizes live music performers of blues, jazz and folk. The Karlik Club invites dance crazes amateurs, where the professional DJs are playing, to satisfy the musical tastes of each student.

The AGH UST Campus has own sport facilities as football, basketball, and volleyball, with artificial turf and tennis courts (open all year). In the near of the AGH UST Campus a modern complex for sport and recreation is located, and which include: sports pool, training pool, recreational pool, hydro massage, jacuzzi, waterslide and a sauna. In this complex you can also take advantage of modern bowling alley, a well-equipped gym and fitness room. The excellent location in the vicinity of the Blonia area and Jordan Park allows runners, cyclists and roller skaters an active spending time in the picturesque verdant landscape of the City.
