Application for Ph.D. type Fellowships in Engineering, cycle 2014 B

We are pleased to inform you that within the framework of the Polish National Commission for UNESCO and the UNESCO Chair for Science, Technology and Engineering Education at the AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow (AGH UST), we invite potential candidates to submit your interest with the fellowships focusing on Ph.D. degree, at the AGH UST Poland, in Engineering, cycle 2014 B, starting from 1st October 2014. The beneficiaries of these fellowships will be given the opportunity to undertake an individual research programme in the field of Science, Technology and Engineering.

The **Annex 01** to this letter provide detailed information regarding to the offered projects and the required qualifications for each field of research (project). The **Annex 02** present the list of invited States per regions. The **Annex 03** include the Application Form for Fellowship in Engineering, edition 2014 B.

This programme is offered in open competition. Only candidates with the necessary qualifications, who meet the criteria stipulated in the annexes, will be selected. Applications should be addressed to the unesco@agh.edu.pl, by **30 June 2014** at the latest.

Holders of the Pole Card and Permit Residence cannot become beneficiaries of the Fellowships Programme and their applications will not be considered.

Facilities offered by the polish authorities:

1. Free tuition and access to the university facilities;
2. Monthly allowance of 1350 PLN (approximately US \$450) corresponding to the salary of a local junior research fellow. Thus, all living expenses in Poland are to be borne by the fellow with this allowance;
3. No provision to finance or lodge family members is made.

At the end of the research studies, the beneficiaries will receive a certificate attesting to their attendance at the host institution.

Facilities offered by the Candidate themself:

1. International return travel expenses;
2. Health insurance for fellowship beneficiaries ;
3. Visa cost.

Fellows, from countries where Polish Embassies or Consulates exist, will have to obtain their entry visa to the country of study prior to their departure. Fellows, from countries where no such Embassy or Consulate exists, must secure their visa through the nearest Embassy of the Republic of Poland.

The candidates' dossiers should include: Application Form, photocopy of the candidates' university diploma, Candidates CV with passport type photo, two letters of recommendation from someone related to the candidate's work, as well confirming the candidate's qualifications, certificate of English language knowledge, duly completed by a relevant authority, if the mother tongue of the candidate is not English.

Candidatures should be submitted by email to unesco@agh.edu.pl by **30 June 2014** at the latest. All correspondence should be in English.
